The FHWA Seminar Room

If you need to hold a meeting with people in different parts of the country or other Centers, but don't have the travel budget, then let the FHWA LTAP/TTAP Clearinghouse help you out!

The LTAP/TTAP Seminar Room, part of FHWA's enterprise-wide Web conferencing system, allows users to meet virtually via the Internet and a teleconference line to collaborate on a document, demonstrate a software system, share knowledge, or enhance job skills.

Store Your PAR Information Online.

Centers have the ability to store PAR data online throughout the year in the password protected Centers Only area of the LTAP/TTAP website. Enter and edit information as often as you would like. The Clearinghouse is also working on an feature this summer that will allow Centers to upload their course information to the web based system.
